

The public statement to the Guam government from Russian asylum seekers locked on Guam

We, refugees who have sought asylum in the United States while staying on the island of Guam, are going on an indefinite hunger strike on **March 1, 2021**, to defend our rights to free movement within the country.

We demand: stop violating the right of refugees to free movement within the country, guaranteed to us by Article 26, Article 6 of the International Convention on the status of refugees, and the protocol ratified by the United States.

Warning: In case of harm to the health or life of the strikers, please hold accountable the US CBP (that is blocking us on the island violating the right to move within the USA) and Guam Government, including Lou Leon Guerrero and Michael San Nicolas (who are deliberately silent and hiding the problem).

All kinds of accompanying financial expenses are also assigned to the Guam government and its responsible persons.

Defense: in the case of an attack on our camp, we will use self-defense. I ask the Governor to cooperate with Guam police department to keep us safe.
